How do we define the City of
Wilmington?

Responses include...

How do we define the City of Wilmington?

- The geographic boundaries as defined by the municipality and the census
- The voting electoral boundaries as defined by the department of elections
- The City of Wilmington (COW) must include Colonial COW residents and programs (i.e., Kingswood)

Other responses include...

Who Are Wilmington Students?

- A Wilmington Student, by definition, is **any student pre-k through grade 12 residing** in the geo boundaries as defined by the municipality, the census and the dept of elections regardless of the school attended locations or the type of school (public, public charter, etc.).
- The aftermath of forced busing during the desegregation court order and afterwards continues to result in persistent fragmentation.
- Any student residing in The City of Wilmington should be included in the data base not just those attending schools physically located in Wilmington.

Other questions/reflections:

- Head Starts, St. Michaels, LACC, Hilltop, etc. How are ECE programs being included in this data and the WLC work?
- Home visiting in Wilmington – data is needed
- WIC data
- Lead screening City of Wilmington data
